2025/26

Children in Reception to Year 6 return to school on **Tuesday 2nd September**. Children in Nursery will start school the week beginning **Monday 8th September**.

For children in Reception to Year 6, school will start at **8:55am**. The school gate will be unlocked 8:45am and children/parents will be able to enter the playground. School will finish at **3:20pm** for children in Reception/Nursery; please collect children from the EYFS outdoor area. School will finish at **3:30pm** for children in Years 1 to 6. Children will be released to parents from their classroom doors.

Uniform

School Dinners

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the 'Universal Infant Free School Meal' Government initiative. Alternatively, parents are permitted to send their child with a packed lunch, if they wish.

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For children in Nursery, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 – hot dinners will be available each day at a cost of **£2.75** per day or £13.75 per week.
