Educational Visit – York Dungeon

Dear Parent/Carer,

In the summer term, our new topic in history will be focused on 'Crime and Punishment'. In order to learn more about this topic, we are planning to take pupils in Eagles to York Dungeon. This is an immersive experience in which pupils can learn more about notable figures from York's past and how justice was served throughout history.

The visit will take place on **Wednesday 15th April**. Children will leave school shortly after registration to travel via coach to York. The class will enjoy a 75-minute tour of the York Dungeons, a packed lunch in Museum Gardens and a walk of the city walls, before returning to Barmby Moor for the end of the school day.

If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal, a school packed lunch can be ordered at no cost. If you require a school packed lunch, please ensure you inform the office staff, via telephone or e-mail by Wednesday 18th March at the very latest.

The full cost of the visit is £24.90 per child, which includes the cost of the transport and entrance to the dungeons. Following a generous donation from Friends of Barmby Moor School and subsidy from school funds, **the cost of the visit is £15.00 per child**. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the visit possible, otherwise the visit will be cancelled and a full refund will be given.

If you would like your child/children to attend, please consent via Scopay and make a payment of £15.00, select Eagles York Dungeon. Alternatively, cash or cheques made payable to ERYC can be placed in the black post box. If using this option, please email consent to the school office by Friday 20th March.
