2026/27 Academic Year

Children in Reception to Year 6 will return to school on **Tuesday 8th September**. Children joining our Nursery will start during the week commencing **Monday 14th September**.

Barmby Moor Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.



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The school day for children in Reception to Year 6 begins at **8:55am**. The school gates will open at **8:45am**, allowing families to access the playground before the start of the day.

At the end of the day, children in Nursery and Reception should be collected from the EYFS outdoor area at **3:20pm**. Children in Years 1 to 6 finish at **3:30pm** and will be dismissed from their classroom doors.

Children in our Kingsfisher class will continue to arrive at school at **8:45am** and finish at **3:00pm**.

The following provides important information about upcoming building works, school uniform, Breakfast and After-School Club, and school dinners ready for the new academic year.

Building Works

During the summer holidays, a number of exciting site improvement projects will be taking place. Thanks to funding secured from East Riding of Yorkshire Council, our staff car park will be refurbished and extended into the former EYFS outdoor area. We have also secured additional funding to upgrade the lighting throughout the school. Both projects are scheduled to be completed during the summer break and are expected to be finished in time for the start of the new academic year in September.

Uniform

The required school uniform is outlined below. Please ensure all uniform is clearly named.

Children in Nursery will wear a red Barmby Moor sweatshirt or cardigan.

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On PE days, children will be required to attend school wearing their outdoor PE kit. Please note there is an expectation that all children have the correct PE kit as outlined below:

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After School Club will be available from 3:30pm until 6:00pm.

- 3:30pm – 4:00pm £3.00 (Session A)
- 3:30pm – 4:30pm £5.00 (Session B)
- 3:30pm – 5:00pm £6.00 (Session C)
- 3:30pm – 5:30pm £9.00 (Session D)
- 3:30pm – 6:00pm £11.00 (Session E)

School Dinners

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the 'Universal Infant Free School Meal' Government initiative. Alternatively, parents are permitted to send their child with a packed lunch, if they wish.

For children in Nursery, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 – hot dinners will be available each day at a cost of **£2.80** per day or £14 per week.
