Remember – try your best!

Monday:

Maths - Finding the area of triangles and parallelograms.

English - An introduction to the poem The Highwayman.

R.E. – Remember last term we studied Eid Mubarak; use the resources on the Class 6 page to learn more about the Islamic festival of Ramadan which started last week.

Tuesday:

Maths – To revise scale factors.

English – To practise using the perfect form.

Local History – Who was Dick Turpin? Have a look at the Horrible Histories song about this real-life Highwayman. Can you write a fact-file about him?

Wednesday:

Maths – To be able to scale similar shapes.

English – To use semi-colons, colons and dashes between clauses.

STEM – Design your own Flutag. If you feel inspired, try to make a flying machine (remember our parachutes lesson).

Thursday:

Maths – Calculating the volumes of cubes and cuboids.

English – Using colons and semi-colons in lists.

PSHE – Today is Captain Tom Moore's birthday! Find out more about who he is and how he has released
