I hope you and your families are all well and that you have enjoyed some fresh air during this lovely weather. I have been gardening and looking at how all my plants are growing and changing. Have you noticed anything new in your gardens?

Thank you for all the great photos you send me on 2Buildaprofile of all the activities you do at home. I love to find out what you are doing with your family. I will continue to email you a range of activities on 2Buildaprofile. I have also added additional ideas for each day if you would like further tasks.

Remember – have fun and try your best!

Monday:

*Find some building bricks or blocks in two different colours. Make a tower using one colour, while your partner makes a tower in the other colour. Are your towers the same? Which tower used fewer bricks? Which has more?

*Ask someone in your house if you can help them. Could you tidy your toys or help to sort the washing? Draw a picture to show how you helped and write a sentence underneath.

Tuesday:

*Go outside and find some flowers or plants. What do they smell like? What colours can you see? Draw a picture and write about the plant.

*Can you find different containers around your house and compare how much water each one holds. How can you find out which one holds the most?

Wednesday:

*Share a story with someone in your house. Maybe you could take it in turns to read some of the words. Can you find some of our tricky words?

*Set up a shop in your house. Can you write price tags for each item? Start by using exact coins and then try to combine coins e.g. 5p and 2p to make 7p. Can you draw which coins you used? Can you write an addition sentence?

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Thursday:

*Have a look at the maths activities on <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/> They are based on a story which you might have at home.

*Play a memory game like 'Kim's game'. Collect about 10 things from around your house and put them on a tray. Look at them carefully and try to remember what is there. Cover them up and ask someone to take one item away. Can you work out which one is missing?

Friday:

*Go for a number hunt around your house. Write down all the numbers you can find. They might be in books, on food boxes or lots of other different places.

*Hide a toy somewhere in your house. Make a map for someone else to follow to help them find it. Don't forget to add labels to your map to make it easier to follow.
