Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you all had a good weekend.

As you will be aware we have now welcomed Nursery (FS1), Reception (FS2), Year 1 and Year 6 children back into school. Thank you for your support during the wider reopening of the school and for the lovely feedback we have received from the children and parents.

As was mentioned in my previous correspondence, we continue to adhere to the Government and East Riding guidance. Due to limitations stipulated in regards to maximum class sizes, our school does not have sufficient staffing or space to accommodate additional year groups at this time. We will update you if this changes.

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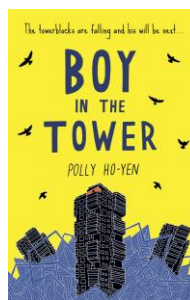
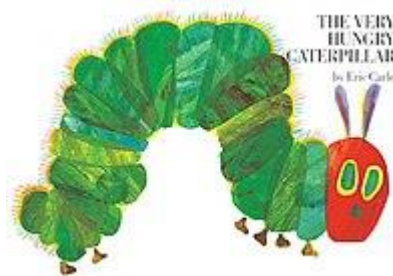
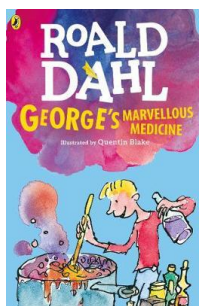


Payments

Kingswood

As you will be aware, we have been in communication with Kingswood in regards to refunds for the June 2020 Year 5/6 Residential. This has been a difficult and lengthy process for the school which recently required the support of the East Riding's Legal department to ensure matters were dealt with in accordance with the agreed terms and conditions.

On Friday, Kingswood contacted our school via e-mail and have offered a refund for the residential visit, minus the initial non-refundable deposits of £40 per child. The Local Authority have recommended that we accept this refund and complete an insurance claim to recover the non-refundable deposits through the East Riding's insurance scheme.

As soon as we receive the refund from Kingswood into our school fund account, we will be in contact with parents to organise refunds. We will keep parents updated as to when the insurance claim has been processed in terms of initial deposits. Thank you for your continued patience.
