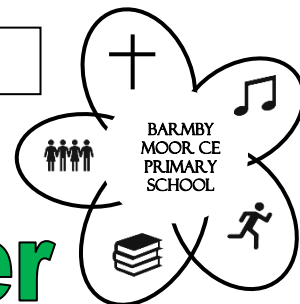

MUSIC LESSONS

Please note that if you collect your child after 6pm (the closing time of the After School Club), you will be charged an additional £5.00 for every 15 minutes (or part of) you are late.

Class 2 (Year 1/2) – Wednesday and Friday

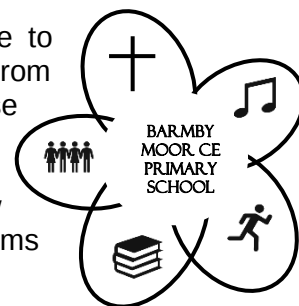
Class 3 (Year 3/4) – Monday and Wednesday

Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 receive a daily piece of fruit under the Government's Free Fruit and Vegetable Scheme.

Pupils in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) are welcome to bring in a piece of fruit from home for morning break.
