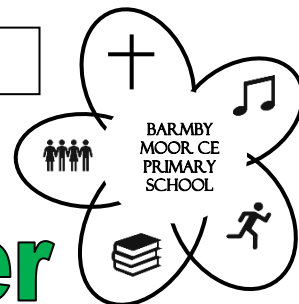

Thank you to all parents for sending children in their PE kits on PE days. These are as follows:

On PE days, please send your child to school wearing their outdoor PE kit. Outdoor PE kit is: blue/black jogging bottoms or leggings; a royal blue or white t-shirt; blue/black sports hoody/top and trainers.

MUSIC LESSONS

Please be reminded that Music lesson fees for this term are now due. The cost is £35 per term for each instrument – this can be paid in two halves if you wish. Cheques should be made payable to East Riding of Yorkshire Council. Thank you.
