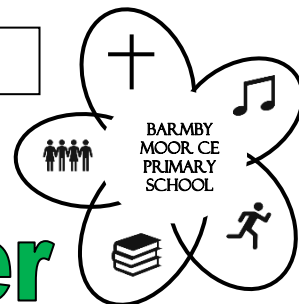

RECEPTION TO YEAR 6 NASAL FLU VACCINATION PROGRAMME



As stated in the letter texted to parents earlier this week, on **Thursday 5th November**

IntraHealth will be carrying out the free nasal flu vaccination programme in school for pupils in Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6.

The letter *Flu Vaccination Programme_Year Reception-Year 6_14.10.2020* contains a link to an online consent form. The link will close on **28th October 2020**. The letter can be accessed on the school website www.barmbymoos.com>Information>Letters.

If you have any problems accessing the link or this is not your preferred method and would like to provide consent via the telephone, please contact **the immunisation team** on 0333 358 3397 option 9.

Further information regarding the nasal flu vaccination programme can be found in the two IntraHealth parent letters on the school website. These are *IntraHealth_Introduction for Parents* and *IntraHealth_Parents E-Consent Introduction*. Parents are encouraged to read these.

If any parent wishes to withdraw their child's consent from the nasal flu vaccination (once consent has been given), they must contact the immunisation team on 0333 358 3397 option 9 – this is the only way that parents will be able to withdraw consent.

Please be reminded of sibling drop-off arrangements. Siblings should be dropped off at the same time. For example, if you have a child in Class 1 and Class 5, both children should be dropped off at the earlier arrival time and collected at the later finish time. Teachers are on duty in the classrooms to receive pupils.

For FS1 pupils (red tops) and 2 year olds, the morning session collection time is 11:40am.

We request that parents ensure they adhere to the timings for their child/ren – this helps social distancing measures on the school site.
