Dear Parent/Carers,

I hope you are all well.

I would like to begin by thanking all parents. You are all doing a wonderful job, whether that is helping your child learn remotely from home or if you are a critical worker and your child is accessing school provision. The children continue to show such resilience and we continue to be proud of each and every one of them.

We remain here to support all of our parents and families during this time. Weekly phone calls will continue to be made by class teachers to the parents of children working remotely. These are an opportunity for parents to raise any concerns or ask for any guidance in terms of remote learning. I am also available should any parents wish to speak to me. Please do get in touch if you require support.

As you will be aware, last week Boris Johnson announced that schools in England would remain closed, except for children of critical workers, until at least Monday 8th March. I will continue to update you as and when we receive further information from the Government.

Remote Learning

We continue to receive positive feedback from parents in relation to the remote education we are providing to children who are at home. Resources will continue to be uploaded to Seesaw on a daily basis. Please be aware teaching staff will respond to any queries and feedback on work as soon as possible.

Resources for remote learning will continue to be uploaded up to and including Friday 12th February and will resume on Monday 22nd February.

If you do not have a device on which your child can carry out remote learning or you do not have adequate internet access, then please contact the School Office and we will be in touch to offer further support.

Critical Worker Provision

We continue to offer provision for the children of critical worker parents. Government guidance continues to state that:

'Parents and carers who are critical workers should keep their children at home if they can.'

If you are a critical worker working from home and your child can access remote learning from home, then they should do so rather than attend school. It is important we keep the number of children in school to a minimum, wherever possible, to reduce the risk of transmission. In addition, if you are a critical worker and only require your child to access school provision for part of the week then please only book your child into school for the required sessions.

During this period, Breakfast Club and After School Club should only be used by the parents of critical worker children when necessary, again to reduce the risk of transmission.

Half-Term

In line with the most recent Government guidance, school will not be open during the half-term break. School provision for children whose parents are critical workers will recommence from Monday 22nd February. Next week we will write to critical worker parents with instructions for booking provision for after half-term.
