Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you are all well.

As we approach the end of the first half of the spring term, I would like to thank all parents and carers for your ongoing support. All children have worked extremely hard whether learning in school or remotely from home.

Please find below important information regarding critical worker provision, remote education and reporting a positive COVID-19 test result.

Critical Workers

As you will be aware, we have provided provision for children of critical worker parents since schools closed at the start of January 2021.

We currently await the Government's official announcement on the full reopening of schools and have been told that the earliest schools could open is Monday 8th March.

We will continue to offer critical worker provision for at least the first two weeks after the half-term break – Monday 22nd February to Friday 26th February and Monday 1st March to Friday 5th March. Please note that if critical worker children can access remote education from home, then they should do so.

We are currently only taking critical worker provision bookings up to and including Friday 5th March. If schools are not fully reopening on the 8th March, we will write to parents again asking them to book in for provision beyond that date.

If you have been accessing critical worker provision, and require provision during the first two weeks after half-term, please e-mail your requirements to barmbymoore.primary@eastriding.gov.uk stating:

- The name of your child.
- The dates and times you will require provision for.
- If you require and Breakfast and/or After School Clubs.

Please use the subject heading 'Critical Worker Provision' in your e-mail and e-mail any requirements by 10am on Friday 12th February.

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Remote Education

Thank you to all parents who have completed our remote learning survey that we sent out to parents by text earlier this week. The survey will continue to be available until Friday 12th February and can be accessed by clicking the following link: <https://forms.gle/HUZrKf6FxSnJ1gAv9>.

We will continue to upload remote learning resources up until Friday 12th February. There will be no remote education during the February half-term break and remote learning will recommence from Monday 22nd February for at least the first two weeks of the new half-term.

Please note that the Seesaw app will not be monitored by class teachers between Saturday 13th February and Sunday 28th February.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 during the half-term break, then please follow the instructions below:

- Where a pupil, who has been in school, tests positive for COVID-19 anytime from 3:30pm on Sunday 14th February onwards, school should not be contacted. Parents and carers instead should follow the contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace and further information can be found at <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/> or by calling 119.
- Where a pupil, who has been in school during the week beginning Monday 8th February, tests positive for COVID-19 between 3:30pm on Friday 12th February and 3:30pm on Sunday 14th February, then school must be contacted so that we can assist in identifying close contacts and advise self-isolation, as individuals may have been infectious whilst in school. Please inform school by e-mailing barmbymoorschool.primary@eastriding.gov.uk. If this happens, then we will contact anyone identified as a close contact via our Teachers2Parents text messaging system.
