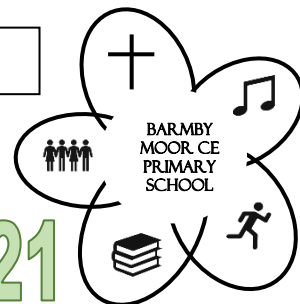

LATERAL FLOW DEVICE (LFD) TESTS

REMINDER



Lateral flow device (LFD) tests are used to identify people with COVID-19 who are not showing symptoms. Lateral flow device testing is currently being offered to people who do not have symptoms, in a range of different settings. They are being used for regular testing of NHS and social care staff, as well as in universities, schools, care homes and other workplaces. LFDs are not intended to be used for anyone who has symptoms of COVID-19. If a person does have any symptoms, then a PCR test must be arranged as soon as possible.

Symptoms include:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

You and anyone you live with should stay at home until you get your PCR test result. Only leave your home to have a test. Anyone in your childcare or support bubble should also stay at home if you have been in close contact with them since your symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started.

COVID-19 REMINDER

It is very important that we all adhere to the Government directives in relation to COVID-19 and we appreciate your continued co-operation in this matter.



Please be reminded of the staggered class drop-off and collection times – see table below.

Class 1 (Nursery/Reception)	9:00am	3:00pm
Class 2 (Year 1/2)	9:05am	3:15pm
Class 3 (Year 3/4)	8:50am	3:25pm
Class 4 (Year 5)	8:55am	3:30pm
Class 5 (Year 6)	8:45am	3:20pm

Siblings should be dropped off at the same time. For example, if you have a child in Class 1 and Class 5, both children should be dropped off at the earlier arrival time and collected at the later finish time. Teachers are on duty in the classrooms to receive sibling drop-offs. For FS1 pupils (red tops) and 2 year olds, the morning session collection time is 11:40am.

TEST AND TRACE SUPPORT PAYMENT

Please be reminded of the Test and Trace Support Payment.

From 8th March, parents or guardians who are not legally required to self-isolate can apply for a Test and Trace Support Payment or discretionary payment if they need to take time off work to care for a child or young person who:

- is aged 15 or under (or 25 or under with an Education, Health and Care Plan) and normally attends an education or childcare setting
- has been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or by their education or childcare setting because they have been identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

The Local Authority is responsible for verifying the self-declared information provided in the parent or guardian's application. This includes checking the following:

- the child's name, age and main address
- the child's first day of self-isolation
- that the child didn't continue to attend the education or care setting when they should have been self-isolating

- whether the communication from the education or care setting is genuine (if this has been submitted by the applicant)

PE NEWS

In Key Stage One, pupils have the opportunity to participate in after-school sports club on Tuesday afternoons. Please speak to Mr Hone or contact the school office for more information.

In Upper Key Stage Two, pupils have the opportunity to participate in an after-school running club with Mr Hone on Friday afternoons. Please contact Mr Hone for further information.

As the end of the academic year approaches, we will be hoping to organise a Sports Day for pupils across school. However, in what format this will take place is dependent on the Government's decisions on the lifting of COVID-19 restrictions. Further information regarding Sports Day and how it will be organised this year will be provided later this half term.

Children need to wear their PE kit to school on their class's PE days – see below. Children require correct school PE uniform on these days which include: **a t-shirt, jogging bottoms or leggings, shorts, a jumper or hoody and a hair bobble**. PE kit should be in the school colours which are: **blue, black or grey and white**. Please be reminded that **children will be asked to remove all jewellery** including earrings for their own safety. In addition to this, children **must have trainers** to take part in PE.

Class 1 (FS1/FS2) – Tuesday and Friday
Class 2 (Year 1/2) – Tuesday and Friday
Class 3 (Year 3/4) – Tuesday and Friday
Class 4&5 (Year 5 & 6) – Tuesday and Friday

From 7.45am (including breakfast)	£4.00
From 8.20am (excluding breakfast)	£2.00

Our revised After School Club charges remain in place and are as follows:

3.30-4.30pm	£4.00
3.30-5.00pm	£5.00
3.30-5.30pm	£8.00
3.30-6.00pm	£10.00

If your child stays at the After School Club for up to 30 minutes there will be a £2.00 charge (excludes a snack).

Please note that if you collect your child after 6pm (the closing time of the After School Club), you will be charged an additional £5.00 for every 15 minutes (or part of) you are late.
