Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you are all well.

We have reached the end of another very different academic year, which has seen children access learning in school and remotely at home. The children, as always, have shown such resilience and we are proud of every single one of them. I would also like to thank all parents/carers for your continued support; this has meant a great deal to staff across school.

Today, we say a fond farewell to our Year 6 children. We wish them every success for the future; they have been valuable members of our school and will be sadly missed. We do hope they will not be strangers and will come back to visit us and inform us of their achievements and progress.

School exercise books from the 2020/21 academic year will be sent home before October half-term.

We are delighted that we can look forward to more normality in our day to day routines when we welcome children back to school in September. In order for you to prepare for this, we have provided some important information below:

Classes

Return Dates

- On **Tuesday 7th September** children from Reception (Foundation Stage Two) to Year 6 return to school.
- Week beginning 13th September, Nursey Children (Foundation Stage One) return to school.

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Removal of Class Bubbles

- Following Government guidance, we will no longer use the class bubble system in school. This means children will once again be able to mix during break and lunchtimes and that whole school gatherings, including daily Collective Worship and events involving parents, can take place as normal.

Start and Finish times

- There will be, in line with Government guidance, no staggered start and finish times for children.
- School will start for all children at **8:55am**. The side gate will be unlocked at 8:45am and children/parents will be able to enter the playground. When the bell rings, children will need to line up with their class teacher, who will then lead them into school. Children in Class 1 should be dropped off at the Class 1 door.
- School will finish at **3:20pm** for children in Class 1. Please collect children from the Class 1 outdoor area.
- School will finish at **3:30pm** for children in Class 2, 3 and 4. Children will be released to parents from their classroom doors.
- If for any reason you are going to be late dropping your child off at school, then please phone the School Office to inform them of your expected arrival time.

Please note the School Office will be accessible to parents, however we request, where possible, that parents use e-mail/telephone if they need to speak to a member of staff.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

- Both Breakfast Club and After School Club will resume on **Tuesday 7th September 2021**.
- Breakfast Club will be available from 7:45am until 8:55am.
 - From 7:45am (including breakfast) £4.00
 - From 8:20am (excluding breakfast) £2.00
- After School Club will be available from 3:30pm until 6:00pm.
 - 3:30pm – 4:00pm £2.00
 - 3:30pm – 4:30pm £4.00
 - 3:30pm – 5:00pm £5.00

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- 3:30pm – 5:30pm £8.00
- 3:30pm – 6:00pm £10.00

- During Breakfast Club and After School Club children will no longer be sitting in class bubbles and instead will be able to mix.

Uniform

- Children will be required to wear their normal school uniform as outlined below:

Reception to Year 6	
Winter	Royal blue Barmby Moor sweatshirt or cardigan School t-shirt Grey or black school trousers (long or short) Grey or blue skirt or pinafore A pair of indoor shoes
Summer	School t-shirt and grey or black shorts Gingham checked dress or school t-shirt and grey or blue skirt or shorts

- Children in Nursery will wear a red Barmby Moor sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Please ensure all uniform is clearly named.
- On PE days, children will be required to attend school wearing their outdoor PE kit. Please note there is an expectation that all children will have the correct PE kit from September 2021 as outlined below:

Reception to Year 6
Summer • A dark blue t-shirt with the Barmby Moor School logo • Plain black shorts • A spare pair of socks

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- A pair of trainers
- Hair bobbles for long hair
- Ear tape for recently pierced ears

Winter

- A dark blue t-shirt with Barmby Moor School logo
- Plain black jogging bottoms or running tights
- A plain black hoody
- A waterproof coat
- A spare pair of socks
- A pair of trainers
- Hair bobbles for long hair
- Ear tape for recently pierced ears

Y5/6 Swimming

- A swimming costume (one pieces please)
- A towel
- Children should come to school in their swimming costumes, wearing their winter PE kit over the top
- Children with long hair would benefit from a hair bobble or a turbie-twist
- Swim socks if necessary
- Goggles are optional

- We will inform parents of PE days on Monday 6th September.

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School Dinners

- School dinners will be available and children will eat their dinner in the School Hall.
- Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the 'Universal Infant Free School Meal' Government initiative. Alternatively, parents are permitted to send their child with a packed lunch, if they wish.
- For children in Nursery, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 – hot dinners will be available each day at a cost of **£2.45** per day or £12.25 per week.

Classroom Arrangements

- Children will be seated in either groups or rows.
- We request that children do not bring in toys/equipment from home including pencil cases. We will provide children with any equipment they require.
- Throughout the day, children will continue to clean their hands on a regular basis. Hands will be washed at the start of the day, after break time, at dinner time, at the end of the school day and after coughing/sneezing.
- Children may bring a water bottle to school. Please ensure this is clearly labelled.

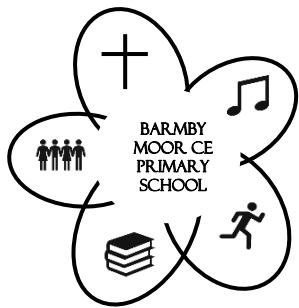
Curriculum

- Our curriculum will remain broad and balanced and there will be a continued focus on catch up.
- Children will focus on learning linked to the National Curriculum subjects.
- Reading books will be sent home with children and changed regularly.
- Homework will continue to be sent on Friday via the Seesaw app.
- Throughout the 2021/22 academic year, we will be taking children on educational visits to further enhance the curriculum.

Illness

- If your child is ill then please **do not** send them to school and contact the School Office, via phone/e-mail, to let school know.
- If a child has a high temperature/cough/loss of smell or taste, then they will need to take a COVID-19 test. If the result is positive, then the child must isolate at home for 10 days.
- If your child develops COVID-19 symptoms within school time, we will contact you immediately and you will be required to collect your child and then follow the procedure above.
- If the school has a positive case of COVID-19, then children who have been in contact with the child/adult will not need to isolate if contacted by NHS Test and Trace. This is in line with the latest Government guidance.
