Dear Parent/Carer,

On Monday 20th September, we have arranged for Years 5 and 6 to visit 'Askham Bryan Wildlife Park' near York to launch our work on rainforests in the Autumn Term. Children will take part in a workshop to learn more about rainforest creatures and their habitats. They will also receive a tour which is guided by experts at the wildlife park. We believe this will help to extend the pupils' knowledge and understanding within Science and Geography.

This will be a full day trip for Years 5 and 6. Therefore, children will require a packed lunch and a drink which can be disposed of easily. We encourage the children to use paper bags where possible to reduce plastic waste. As the weather is unpredictable, it is recommended that the children bring waterproofs in case it rains. Children should arrive at school promptly for 8:55 am as we will be leaving school by coach at 9:15 am. We will return to school in time for the end of the school day.

The cost of the visit is £11.96 per child, which includes the cost of the transport, workshop and tour. Under the 1996 Education Act **the school requests a voluntary contribution of £6.00** if you wish your child to take part in this visit. The remaining cost will be subsidised by School Funds and a £5.00 per child contribution from Friends of Barmby Moor Primary School. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are enough voluntary contributions to make the trip possible otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made. Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support. Please make cheques payable to East Riding of Yorkshire Council. You can also pay in cash to the school office, or you can pay online – please select 'Y5/6 Askham Bryan 2021'.

To give permission for your child to take part in this visit, please email the school office by **Wednesday 15th September 2021**, subject heading 'ASKHAM BRYAN'. During the visit, children may have the opportunity to handle different animals. If your child has any allergies or you do not want him/her to handle the animals, please state this in your email.
