Unfortunately, many children are not taught this vital lesson to improve their personal safety.

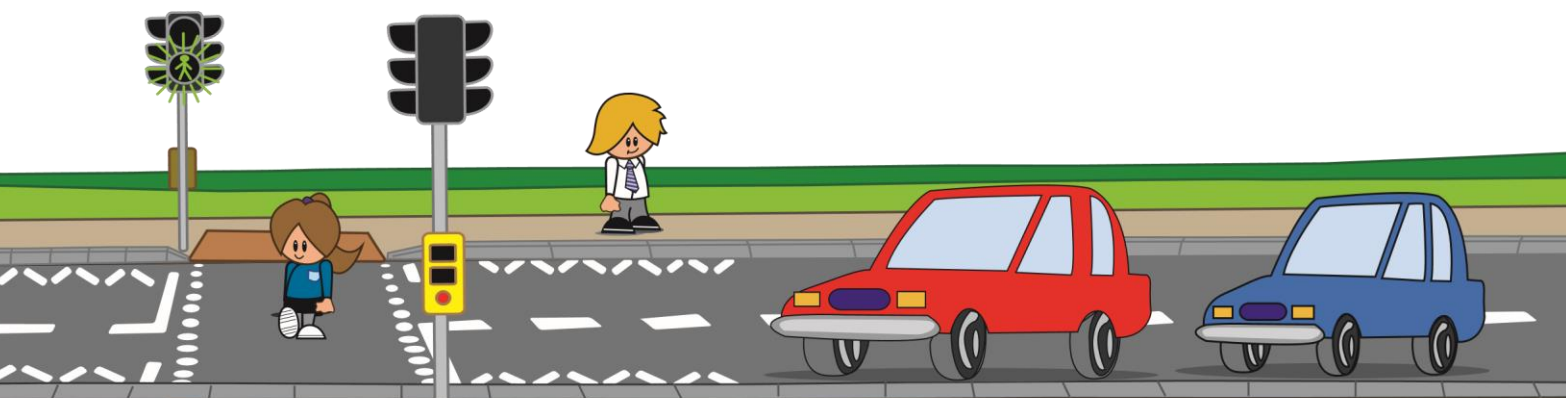
Part of the training will take place in the classroom (COVID rules and risk assessment permitting), however the important part of the training will be out of school, at the roadside, under strict supervision.
