CLASS 3 – NORTH YORK MOORS NATIONAL PARK VISIT, THURSDAY 4th NOVEMBER 2021

Linking to Class 3's Geography and Science work on Rivers and the Water Cycle, an educational visit has been arranged for Year 3 and 4 pupils to the North York Moors National Park Education Centre. This will be a fantastic, hands-on introduction to the topic and children will conduct a river investigation in the great outdoors, learn how rivers erode, transport and deposit materials, and see how animals are adapted to a stream habitat. This visit will be carefully supervised by staff and the activities carried out by the North York Moors National Park education staff.

The visit will take place on Thursday 4th November 2021. We will depart school at the earlier time of 8.15am and return by 3.30pm. Please can children be at school by 8.05am for a prompt departure at 8.15am.

For this visit, children will require a disposable packed lunch (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). Children should wear old, warm clothes and they will also require Wellington boots and a waterproof coat. Please note that Wellington boots are essential for the river activity.

The cost of the visit is £16.86 per child, which includes the cost of the coach and workshop. Under the 1996 Education Act **the school requests a voluntary contribution of £8.00** if you wish your child to take part in this visit. The remaining cost will be subsidised by School Funds and a £5.00 per child contribution from Friends of Barmby Moor Primary School. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are enough voluntary contributions to make the trip possible otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made. Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support. Please make cheques payable to East Riding of Yorkshire Council. You can also pay in cash to the school office, or you can pay online – please select 'Y3/4 North York Moors 2021'.
