CLASS 3 – NATIONAL SCIENCE & MEDIA MUSEUM, BRADFORD, WEDNESDAY 8TH JUNE 2022

This term our topic is “Lights, Camera, Action” where we are looking at leisure & entertainment in the 20th Century. To experience this history hands on, an educational visit has been arranged for Year 3 and 4 pupils to the National Science and Media Museum in Bradford. We will be looking at artefacts from the 20th century, learning facts about this time period, and experiencing an amazing invention of the 20th century: IMAX cinema. We will watch an educational video about the planet in which we will explore the impact of humanity on planet Earth with stunning footage captured by astronauts. This will complement our science curriculum and inspire our children to look after our beautiful planet.

The visit will take place on Wednesday, 8th June. We will depart school at the earlier time of 8.55am and return by 3.30pm. For this visit, children will require a disposable packed lunch (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). Children should wear school uniform.

The cost of the visit is £20.33 per child, which includes the cost of the coach and entry to the museum. Under the 1996 Education Act **the school requests a voluntary contribution of £15.00** if you wish your child to take part in this visit. The remaining cost will be subsidised by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are enough voluntary contributions to make the trip possible otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made. Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.
