Dear Parent and Carers,

As I am sure you are aware, our pupils are very thoughtful and enjoy taking part in lots of different activities to help raise money for those who are in need. As part of our school's continued work on supporting various local, national and international charities, we have decided to organise a fun run event for pupils to participate in.

As 2022 is the year in which the Queen's Jubilee and the Birmingham Commonwealth Games take place, money raised will go towards the Qhubeka charity. Qhubeka is a global charity which provides bicycles for people in Africa (a continent on which many Commonwealth nations are located). Through their programmes, people receive bicycles to improve their access to schools, clinics and jobs. The bicycle is a tool which then helps people to travel faster, further, to generate income and to carry more. In the face of extreme and persistent poverty, bicycles can change lives by allowing children to get an education and adults to earn an income.

For Key Stage Two, we have organised our fun run event to take place on **Friday afternoon, July 1<sup>st</sup> at 2pm**. Key Stage Two children will run a 2 km (1.25 miles) route from school to the recreation ground and back.

In addition to our KS2 fun run event, children from EYFS and Key Stage One will be taking part in a shorter fun run on Friday on the school field. This involves children walking, jogging or running a half mile around the school field.

We are asking for a donation of **£1 per pupil** to help raise money for the worthy charity. **Pupils must have trainers in school in order to complete their challenge.**

If your child is in Key Stage Two, please return the permission slip as soon as possible to the school office, as their event involves running outside of the school grounds.
