Dear Parents/Carers,

We have now received the final report from Ofsted following our inspection which took place on 28th June 2022 and we are delighted to inform you that Barmby Moor CE Primary School continues to be a good school.

When a school has previously been judged to be good, Ofsted will then normally go into the school about once every 4 years to confirm that the school remains good; this is called a section 8 inspection. No graded judgements are given in a section 8 inspection. If Ofsted have deemed that your grade may differ, then the next inspection would be a section 5, where graded judgements are given.

The school was previously judged as good in March 2017 and we are extremely pleased this grading has been retained against the backdrop of COVID and those challenges presented over the last two years.

The report, which will be sent out in a separate text and will be available on our school website, really captures the nature of our school. We are all very proud of our school and are immensely proud that what our staff and pupils achieve has been recognised and endorsed externally through a most rigorous process.

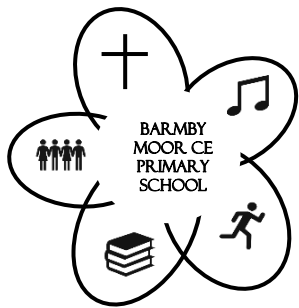
Ofsted said that *'School Leaders have planned a well-organised curriculum that develops pupils' knowledge and expertise across a broad range of subjects', 'which is carefully sequenced from early years through to year 6'. 'Staff instil high expectations of pupils' behaviour right from the start of early years.'*

Ofsted praised *Senior Leaders and Governors for taking into account staff workload. 'For example, changes to the school's marking and feedback system are being carefully monitored to check if workload is being reduced.'*

Ofsted also praised *the work the school is doing to protect children and keep them safe. Inspectors described 'a strong culture of safeguarding' and noted that 'the school works closely with parents and external agencies to keep children safe.'*

Inspectors identified that *'pupils enjoy coming to school and learning with their friends. Parents and carers are exceptionally confident that their children are safe in school. Pupils are polite, respectful, and friendly to each other.'*

Barmby Moor Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.
