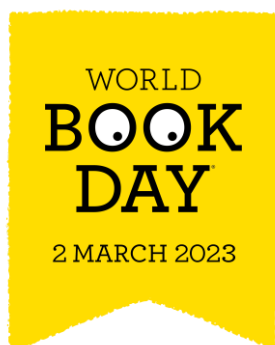
## CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH WEEK – DRESS TO EXPRESS FUNDRAISER
