Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are well.

You will be aware that members of the National Education Union have been carrying out industrial action over the last few months. The next days of industrial action take place on **Wednesday 5th July** and **Friday 7th July**.

I have engaged with all relevant stakeholders and am now able to inform you of the impact this will have on Barmby Moor. **Due to projected staffing levels on the above days, school will be closed for Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 pupils.**

Please note that Mrs Rooke's Choir trip to Birmingham, which takes place on Friday 7th July, will continue as planned.

School will be open for Nursery pupils and pupils whose parents/carers are classed as critical workers. However, due to staffing levels, we ask that critical worker provision is only accessed as a last resort and priority will be given to NHS staff workers and emergency service workers. If you feel you will require the critical worker provision, please e-mail school (barmbymoorschool.primary@eastriding.gov.uk) stating your critical worker role along with supporting evidence.

Critical worker children in school will have normal school meal provision on both days. Those children not in school but who entitled to a free school meal will be able to collect a lunch parcel from school on the day. Please contact school directly if you would like a lunch parcel so we know how many to prepare. These will be ready to collect between 12pm and 1pm on the day from the school office.

Breakfast and after school club provision will be available as part of critical worker provision.

Children who are in school will not be accessing the national curriculum.

I would like to take this opportunity to emphasise that striking is the right of every teacher who is part of a union and is a personal choice, which we respect as a school. Staff are not required to inform us of their intention to take strike action. I would like to take this opportunity to stress that this is not a decision any member of staff will have taken lightly. These decisions have been taken with the wish to safeguard the long-term future of the education system.

I appreciate that this school closure may cause you inconvenience and disruption, however this has unfortunately been unavoidable.

Barmby Moor Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.



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We will continue to communicate with you and keep you updated on arrangements or any changes to the planned strike action.
