Dear Parents/Carers

Class 4 Visit to Howsham Mill

We are delighted to inform you that the pupils in Class 4 will visit Howsham Mill on Thursday 1st February 2024. Children will take part in workshops on the themes of soil and rock investigation as part of their Science topic.

The children and adults will be transported to Howsham Mill by coach and will depart from school at 9.15 a.m. and will return back to school for 3:00 p.m.

Please can we request that the children come to school dressed in their warmest clothing; school uniform is not required. Pupils will be outside so wearing plenty of layers is advised to keep warm; a fleece and jogging bottoms would be ideal. It is also important that the children wear a waterproof coat, wellies or walking boots, hat, gloves and very warm socks as it can be very cold and wet.

Pupils will require a packed lunch to be provided from home, in a disposable plastic bag. If your child receives Free School Meals a school packed lunch can be ordered from school. If you require a school packed lunch, please ensure you inform the office staff, via telephone or e-mail, by **Friday 26th January 2024**, at the very latest.

The full cost of the visit is £5.85 per child, which includes the cost of the transport and activities. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£5.00**, this can be paid via Scopay or cash. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made.

Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.

Please provide consent for your child's participation for the visit via Scopay or email. Please note children will not be permitted to take part unless parental consent is received.
