Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of providing a broad curriculum for our children in Class 1, we are excited to offer our Reception children an opportunity to visit Breckenholme Farm to undertake an Education Farm Discovery Day. The children will partake in a 'Focus on Sheep' day where we will spend time with a farmer, who will explain how flocks are managed. The children will also meet a shepherd and have contact with young ewes and lambs. We will also enjoy a walking tour of the farm. I am certain this will be a wonderful experience for the children.

The children will be travelling by coach and they will be leaving school at approximately 9.30am on Friday 12th April 2024.

Children should wear school uniform, however please provide a waterproof coat and wellies as it may well be muddy!

Your child will need a packed lunch including a drink (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please) in a disposable bag. As your child is eligible for universal free school meals, you may order a school packed lunch. If you wish to order a packed lunch, please email the school office, specifying if they would like a ham or cheese sandwich.

The cost of the visit is £19.00 per child, which includes the cost of the transport, as entrance to the farm is free. This year, Friends of Barmby Moor Primary School have generously made available £8 per child for this visit.

The cost of the visit is £11.00 per child. Under the 1996 Education Act the **school requests a voluntary contribution of £10.00** if you wish your child to take part in this visit. The remaining balance will be subsidised by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are enough voluntary contributions to make the trip possible otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made. Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school office for further information about financial support.

Please make a **£10.00** payment via Scopay and select Class 1 Farm Visit; this allows you to add consent for the visit. Alternatively, cash or cheques, made payable to East Riding of Yorkshire Council, can be placed in a named envelope in the black post box. If using this option, please email consent to the school office.
