Applying for the Pupil Premium Grant

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are sure you will be aware that all children in Foundation Stage Two (Reception) and Key Stage One (Years One and Two) are automatically entitled to receive free school meals. You may also be aware that some pupils in Key Stage Two (Years Three to Six) also qualify for free school meals based on eligibility criteria relating to household income. This is known as the Pupil Premium Grant. In addition to free school meals, successful application for the Pupil Premium Grant also allows us as a school to support with the cost of:

- educational visits
- residential visits
- extra-curricular clubs
- before and after school club wrap-around care
- music lessons
- new resources for the classroom, and
- access to ELSA support

In order to claim this funding, you need to reach certain eligibility criteria. You can check if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant by applying on-line by visiting www.eastriding.gov.uk/ppg. If you prefer, you can telephone the council's benefits team and given them your name, date of birth, national insurance number, your child's name, date of birth and school they are attending. Once you have provided the required information, you will receive a letter telling you whether or not your child is eligible for the grant.

Please consider whether or not your child may be eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant as we are sure you understand that any additional funding can make a real difference to the school and the progress of all children.

If you would like to access funding for this academic year, please complete your application by the 30th September 2024. Myself, Mr Baxter and Mrs Carr are more than happy to support you with any queries or applications, if needed.
